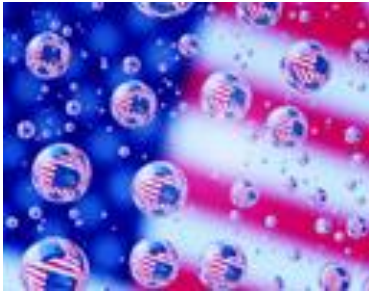
# ***FRESH APPROACH TO THE WORLD WELL TRAVELED***
